- District Clerk Treasurer Menesale stated the notification of the annual meeting will be published in the Cape Cod Times newspaper on April 24, 2024; the Barnstable police detail is set; The determination of the Free Cash and the Ambulance funds will be finalized and these finalized fund amounts will be read on the floor so that the most current financials are read out during the annual meeting

- Commissioner Skende asked about the moderator position status for the annual meeting Commissioner Cross stated he has been contacted by a citizen who expressed interest in being the moderator for the annual meeting
- The moderator will be selected from the floor during the annual meeting; Commissioner Cross will contact the interested citizen to make sure the moderator duties and selection process is understood

- Assistant Chief Storie said Cliffhangers has given a projected date of April 26, 2024 for installation
- Assistant Chief Storie stated the Solar project is delayed as the solar company is working with Eversource to address design items

#### 9. CHIEF'S REPORT

- Assistant Chief Storie stated FF Jeff Bourne has resigned
- 4 new FFs will start the Fire Academy on April 22, 2024; these FFs' scheduled graduation date is June 28, 2024
- Regarding the boat project, the boat is up; there are no delays and the boat project is on schedule
- Assistant Chief Storie said there were 2 fires in the past couple of weeks; one fire was a boat fire at the docks; there was no damage to the pier, passengers or any other boats; Assistant Chief Storie stated the HFD team did an outstanding job especially due to the challenges the HDF faced while extinguishing this boat fire
- Assistant Chief Storie mentioned that Lieutenant (Lt.) John Poolio was the supervisor in charge of this emergency; the board thanked Lt. Poolio for his exemplary leadership in supervising the HFD response to this challenging boat fire
- Assistant Chief Storie said the second fire was a fire at the Cape Cod Mall; there was some complexity to this fire due to its origination location; HFD did another outstanding job in containing this small, but complex fire successfully
- Assistant Chief Storie said the run rate currently is 1,927; this run rate is down 128 runs compared to the year over year data
- Assistant Chief Storie stated the run decrease can be linked to the lack of major weather events and the normal fluctuations of run occurrence
- Chairperson Cronin mentioned citizens often comment to her on the excellence of the HFD's response to emergency situations; Chairperson Cronin thanked Assistant Chief Storie and the HFD for their continued quality in the varied tasks they complete
