By-Law committee:

## 9. CHIEF'S REPORT

- Chief Burke stated there are a couple of items to discuss regarding the insurance term date; if they move the insurance term date, they would have to cancel the policy and then rewrite the policy and start new; the second item is that the policy term date cannot be moved to March
- Commissioner Skende asked how much the variance is between years; Chief Burke said not much
- The board discussed the different options and its financial impact on the district
- The board decided that it may be better to keep the term renewal date as is, but the board should have the review happens earlier in a regular meeting
- Chief Burke stated the Training Captain position has been posted
- 4 candidates will be giving the process dates next week
- Chief Burke said HFD has sent out 6 candidates their conditional offers; now the testing will begin
- 2 out of the 6 candidates need fire academy graduation to ensure that all employees are the same level skills-wise
- The physical exam and written exam will be administered
- Call volume is about 150 calls under last year
- The board discussed the current status of the HFD vehicles and any future plans to replace any HFD vehicles
- Commissioner Cross mentioned the rescue last week off Old Colony Road which he had observed; he stated the interaction he had with and observed of the FF crew was very respectful of the public that was starting to gather around the emergency scene
- The board discussed Chief Burke's opioid presentation that he prepared for the conference and the impacts that opioid problems have on emergency services
- Chief Burke said Assistant Chief Storie's retirement party will be on September 15; Chief Burke will send the details to the commissioners
